

# BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS

The Grundy County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on May 16, 2016, at 9:00 A.M. Chairperson Smith called the meeting to order with the following members present: Bakker, Ross, Riekema, and Schildroth.

Motion was made by Bakker and seconded by Riekema to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Ross and seconded by Schildroth to approve Utility Permit Application No. 5-09-16 to Heart of Iowa Communications of Union, Iowa, on fiber cable installation per map attached to said application located in Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 18, 19, and 20 of Melrose Township and to authorize the chairperson to sign said application. Carried unanimously.

Gary Mauer, County Engineer, reviewed department matters with the Board.

Motion was made by Ross and seconded by Bakker to table approval of the Courthouse Security Plan. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Ross and seconded by Riekema to appoint Steve Robertson to the Zoning Commission for a term ending May 16, 2021. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Ross and seconded by Riekema to appoint Keith Sheller to the Zoning Commission for a term ending May 16, 2021. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Bakker and seconded by Schildroth to reappoint Jane Katzer to the Zoning Commission for a term ending May 16, 2021. The vote was as follows: Ayes – Bakker and Schildroth. Nays – Ross, Riekema, and Smith. Motion defeated 2-3.
